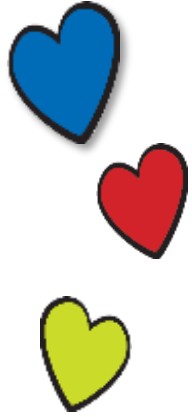

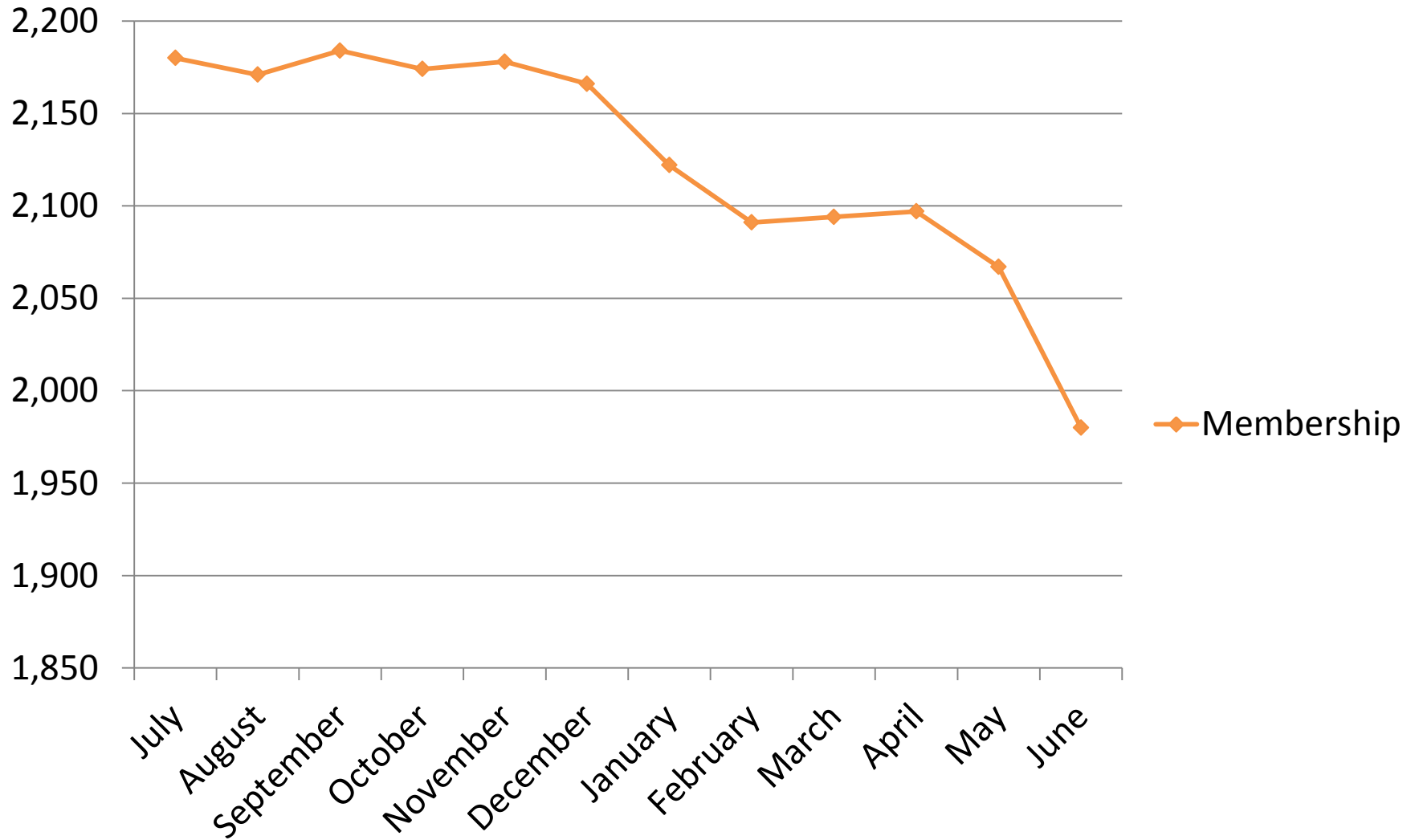
HEALTHY KIDS Program History

- ❖ HK began in 2001
- ❖ Funded mostly by the City & County of SF
- ❖ Administered by the San Francisco Health Plan
- ❖ HK expanded to enroll young adults (ages 19-24) in 2005, and closed in 2009

HEALTHY KIDS Costs

- ❖ Premiums range from \$48 to \$189 for one year of coverage per enrolled member

Healthy Kids Program - Annual Premiums		
\$48/child	\$117/child	\$189/child

- ❖ Co-Pays ranging from \$0 to \$15
 - Cost depends on type of service received



Eligibility

- ❖ Children age 0-18 years
- ❖ Must live in San Francisco
- ❖ Not eligible for:
 - Full Scope Medi-Cal
 - Coverage by ESI (employer sponsored insurance)
- ❖ Any immigrant status: undocumented, qualified immigrant, U.S. Citizen or National
- ❖ At or below 322% FPL (MAGI) – as determined by:
 - ❖ Household size
 - ❖ Household income

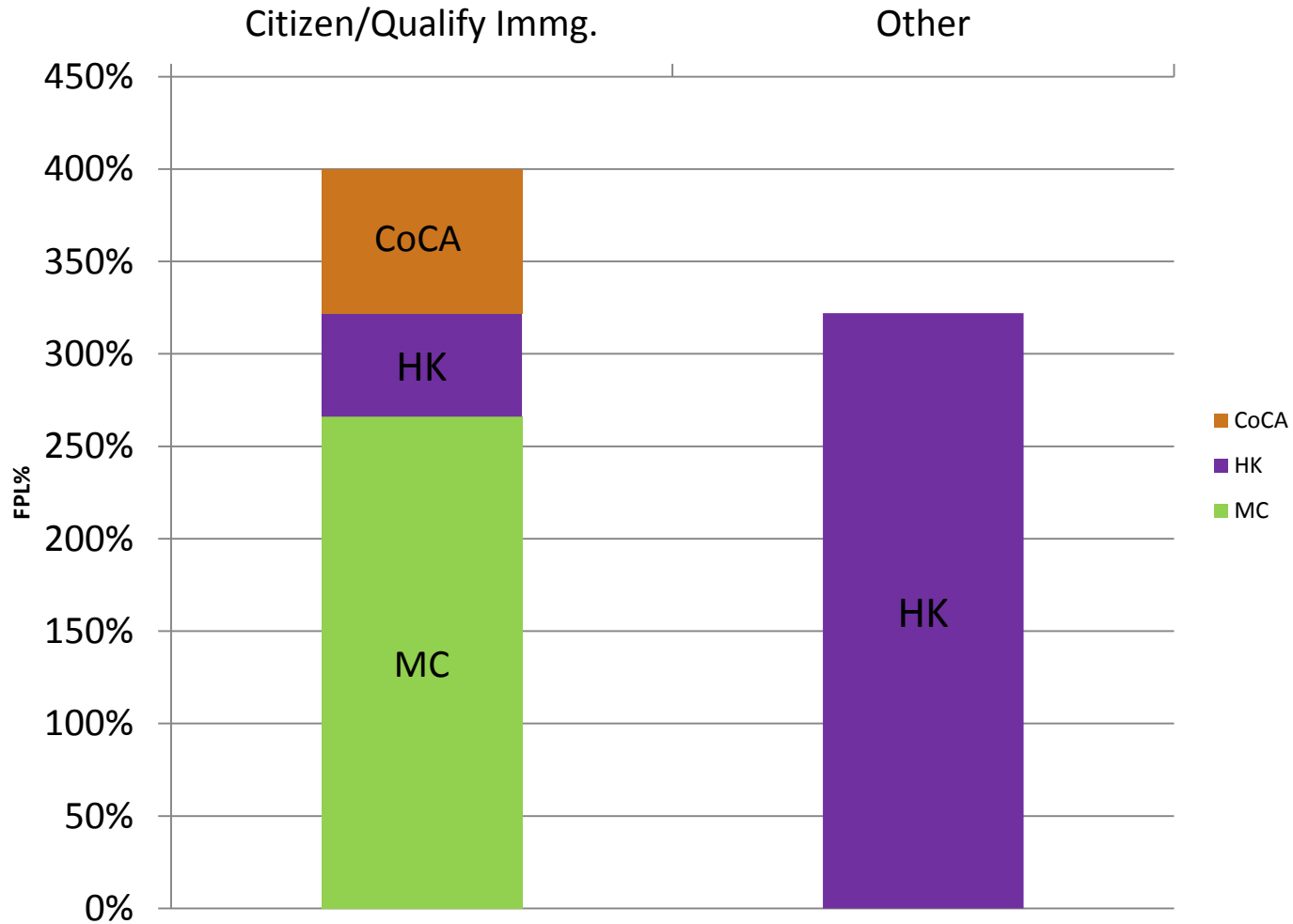

Family of 4

- Jim (Dad) -- \$900 income
- Minnie (Mom) -- \$4,000 monthly
- Jennifer – age 16*
- Victor – age 10



Application Process

- ❖ HK Application Assistors (AAs) can help an applicant complete a HK paper application, which asks for:
 1. Info about the applicant (the person providing the information)
 2. Info about the child(ren) applying for coverage
 3. Gross income before taxes
 4. Family size
 5. Choice of doctor or clinic
- ❖ HK application and supporting documentation can be mailed or faxed (415) 547-7820 to the SFHP Healthy Kids Program



Application Process

A complete application must contain:

- Signed application (Signature & Declaration page for online application)
- Proof of income (Current income and tax return, if applicable)
- Proof of SF residency
- Proof of age
- Proof of citizenship immigration status (if applicable)

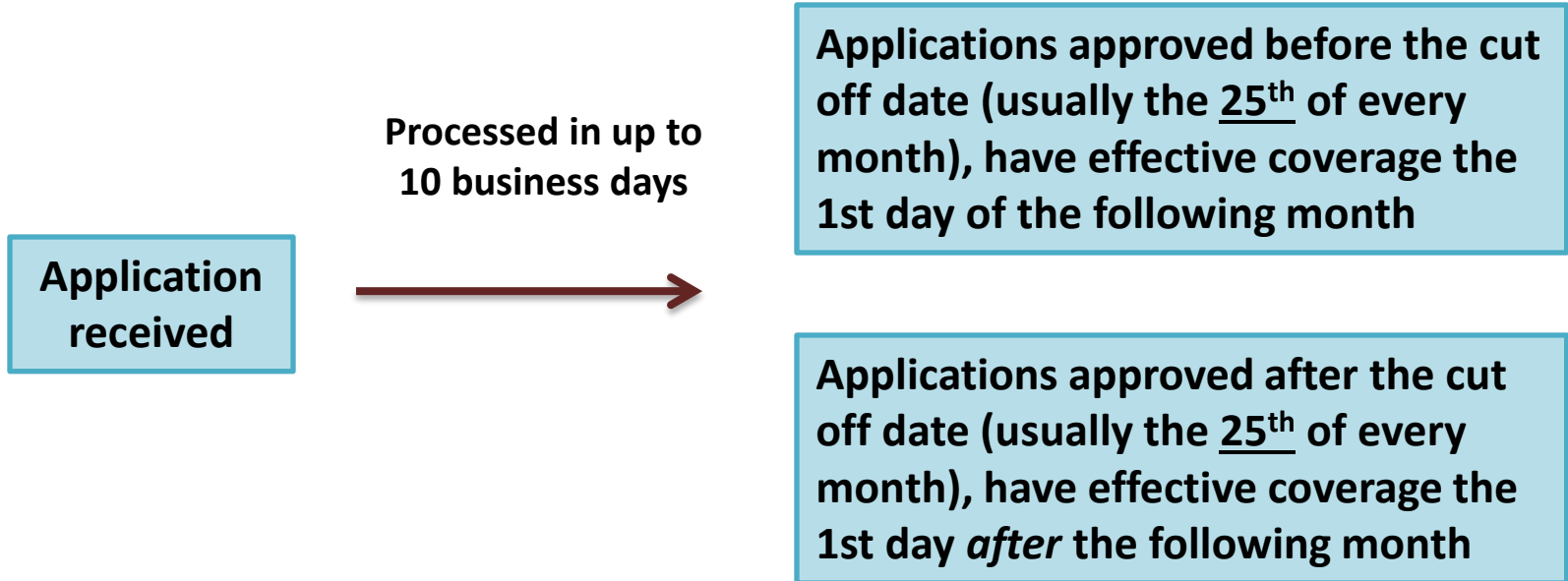

Review Process

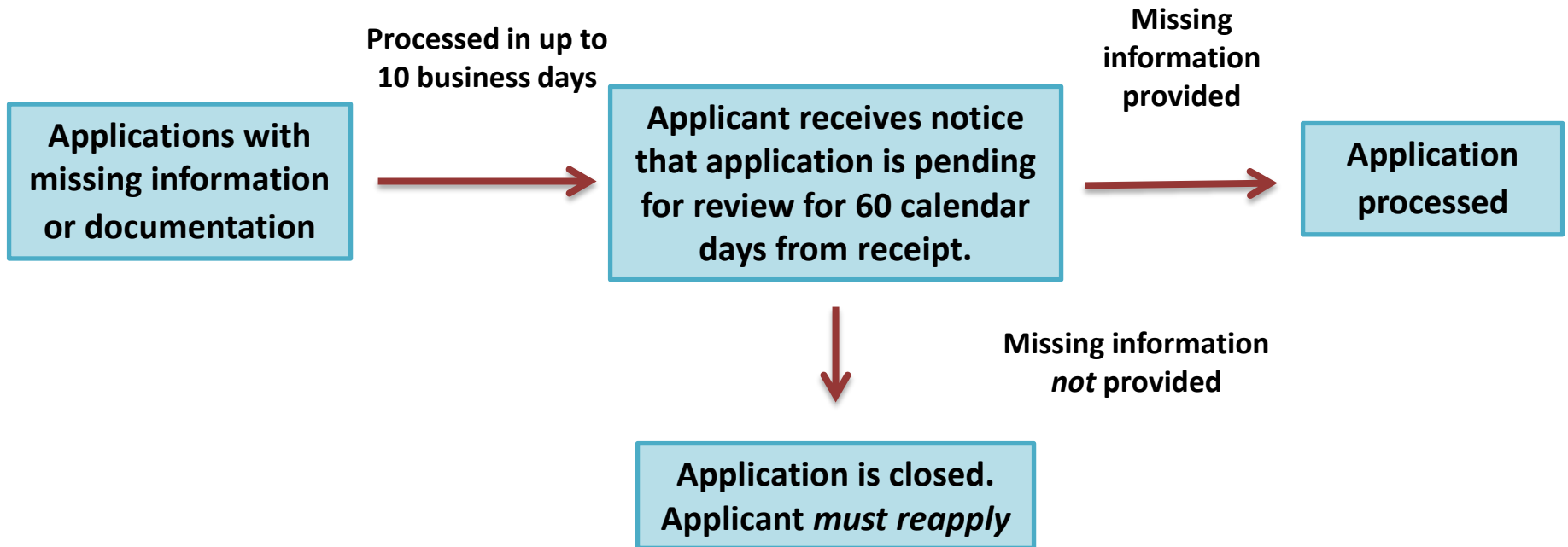
- ❖ Complete applications are processed within 10 business days of receipt





Review Process

❖ For incomplete applications:





AER Process

- ❖ HK members must renew their coverage after 12 continuous months
- ❖ AER Packet is sent to member's household 60 days in advance of coverage termination
- ❖ Annual Eligibility Review (AER) sent must be returned with verifications prior to term date
