Healthy Kids is a health insurance program

offered by San Francisco Department of Public Health and administrated by the San Francisco Health Plan.

Healthy Kids members have access to the following medical services:

Dental Care



Vision Care

Members receive comprehensive health care that includes:








- HK began in 2001
- Funded mostly by the City & County of SF
- Administered by the San Francisco Health Plan
- HK expanded to enroll young adults (ages 19-24) in 2005, and closed in 2009



Membership Trend 2014-2015





Premiums range from \$48 to \$189 for one year of coverage per enrolled member

Healthy Kids Program - Annual Premiums

- Co-Pays ranging from \$0 to \$15
 - Cost depends on type of service received



- Children age 0-18 years
- Must live in San Francisco
- Not eligible for:
 - Full Scope Medi-Cal
 - Coverage by ESI (employer sponsored insurance)
- Any immigrant status: undocumented, qualified immigrant, U.S. Citizen or National
- At or below 322% FPL (MAGI) as determined by:
 - Household size
 - Household income

1. Sanchez's Household Family of 4

- Bob (Dad) -- \$3,500 monthly
- Stacy (Mom) -- \$0 Income
- Lisa age 10
- Jose age 12



2. Jones' Household Family of 4

- Sam (Dad) \$2,500 monthly
- Dora (Mom) \$0 Income
- Grace age 16
- Terence age 8



3. Chan's Household Family of 4

- Jim (Dad) -- \$900 income
- Minnie (Mom) -- \$4,000 monthly
- Jennifer age 16*
- Victor age 10



- HK Application Assistors (AAs) can help an applicant complete a HK paper application, which asks for:
 - 1. Info about the applicant (the person providing the information)
 - 2. Info about the child(ren) applying for coverage
 - 3. Gross income before taxes
 - 4. Family size
 - 5. Choice of doctor or clinic
- HK application and supporting documentation can be mailed or faxed (415) 547-7820 to the SFHP Healthy Kids Program



A complete application must contain:

- Signed application (Signature & Declaration page for online application)
- Proof of income (Current income and tax return, if applicable)
- Proof of SF residency
- Proof of age
- Proof of citizenship immigration status (if applicable)


Application received

Applications approved before the cut off date (usually the <u>25th</u> of every month), have effective coverage the 1st day of the following month

Applications approved after the cut off date (usually the <u>25th</u> of every month), have effective coverage the 1st day *after* the following month



For <u>incomplete</u> applications:





- HK members must renew their coverage after 12 continuous months
- AER Packet is sent to member's household
 60 days in advance of coverage termination
- Annual Eligibility Review (AER) sent must be returned with verifications prior to term date
