


How to Use Your Diskus















50 mcg





















1 Hold it like this



2 Put your thumb here



3 Push thumb this way to open



4 Here is the mouth piece



5 Put your thumb here




6 Push back to click open



Window is open, medicine is inside. Do NOT shake.



8 Breathe OUT and away from the diskus



Close lips around the mouthpiece. **Breathe IN fast** and deep.



10 Hold your breath for 10 seconds if you can




11 Close the diskus



12 Rinse with water





How to Use Your Dry Powder Inhaler

(Asmanex®)





2 Puff (s)





1 Twist bottom like this to remove cap



2 Here is the cap and the mouthpiece



3 Breathe OUT and away from inhaler




4 Put lips around mouthpiece. Breathe IN fast and deep.



5 Hold your breath for 10 seconds if you can



6 Rinse with water and spit out





Put cover on and twist to close

How to Use Your Dry Powder Inhaler (Pulmicort®)

Twist bottom like this to remove cap



2 Here is the cap and the mouthpiece



3 Hold the mouthpiece



4 Twist bottom this way



5 Then back this way to hear "click". Now the inhaler is ready to use



6 Breathe OUT and AWAY from inhaler



Put lips around mouthpiece. Breathe IN fast and deep.



8 Hold your breath for 10 seconds if you can



9 Rinse with water and spit OUT



Put cover back on, twist to close



How to Use A Spacer with Control Inhaler





2 Puff (s)



2 Puff (s)













Take the cap off the inhaler



Shake the inhaler



3 Attach to spacer





4 Take the cap off the spacer



5 Breathe OUT all the way



6 Close lips around mouthpiece



Press down here



8 Breathe IN slow and deep



9 Hold your breath for 10 seconds if you can.



10 Then breathe out slowly



11 If you need another puff of medicine, wait 1 minute then repeat steps 5-10





12 Rinse with water and spit OUT

How to Use Your Spacer and Quick Relief Inhaler





3 Attach to spacer






5 Breathe OUT all the way



6 Close lips around mouthpiece




7 Press down here

STEP 1 Get Your HandiHaler® Ready to Use



A Press green button to open the cap



B Pull cap up




C This is the mouthpiece





D Open the mouthpiece



E Medicine goes in here

STEP 2 Get Your Spiriva® Medicine Ready to Use



A Open one Spiriva® medicine pack



B Pull back here to open Spiriva®



C Take capsule out



Do NOT put capsule in mouth





E Put capsule here



F Close mouthpiece tightly.



G You will hear a click



Press the green button all the way in (only press once). This crushes the medicine inside

D Breathe out and breathe normally




E Breathe in again slow and deep

G Breathe out and breathe normally



H Open the mouthpiece



Remove used capsule



J Close your inhaler
