## **Medication Therapy Management**

Effective **November 1, 2014,** San Francisco Health Plan contracted with OutcomesMTM<sup>™</sup> to offer Medication Therapy Management (MTM) services to Medi-Cal Seniors and Persons with Disabilities members. OutcomesMTM identifies, specially trained Personal Pharmacists in communities throughout San Francisco to deliver these services. By using an OutcomesMTM Pharmacist, members get the extra attention they need to keep their medications on the right track. MTM services may be available face-to-face or via phone. Services offered to members include Comprehensive Medication Review, prescriber or non-prescription consultation and drug information.
