Preventive health drugs are select drugs that are covered at no cost to you under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) and Knox-Keene Health Care Service Plan Act (Knox-Keene Act) Preventive Services coverage requirements. The following is a list of preventive medications, with the indications, that are covered under the San Francisco Health Plan's (SFHP) Outpatient Pharmacy Benefit for Healthy Workers HMO members at \$0 copay per the ACA. This list is last updated 06/30/2025 and is subject to change. <b>Antiretroviral therapy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>emtricitabine 200mg/tenofovir 300mg (generic Truvada)</li> <li>Descovy 200mg/25mg</li> <li>Apretude</li> </ul>	<p>HIV PrEP or PEP, for prevention of HIV. For persons who are at high risk of HIV acquisition.</p> <p>*Regular copay applies for HIV treatment use, where applicable.</p>
<b>Aspirin</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>aspirin 81mg</li> </ul>	Recommended after 12 weeks of gestation in persons who are at high risk for preeclampsia.
<b>Bowel preparation products</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gavilyte -C</li> <li>Gavilyte-G</li> <li>PEG-3350 solution</li> <li>sodium sulfate-potassium sulfate-magnesium sulfate (generic Suprep)</li> </ul>	As a part of preventive screening colonoscopy procedure for adults ages 45 to 75 years old.
<b>Breast cancer prevention drugs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>anastrozole</li> <li>raloxifene</li> <li>tamoxifen</li> <li>letrozole</li> </ul>	As primary prevention of breast cancer in women at increased risk for breast cancer.
<b>Folic acid</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>folic acid 0.4mg, 0.8mg</li> </ul>	For all persons planning to or who could become pregnant to lower the risks of birth defects.
<b>Statins</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>atorvastatin</li> <li>lovastatin</li> <li>pravastatin</li> <li>rosuvastatin</li> </ul>	For adults at higher risk for developing cardiovascular disease (CVD) [such as

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>simvastatin</li> </ul>	having a heart attack or stroke].
<b>Tobacco cessation drugs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>bupropion hcl SR</li> <li>nicotine gum</li> <li>nicotine lozenge</li> <li>nicotine patch</li> <li>nicotine inhaler</li> </ul>	For those who use tobacco products and desire to quit.

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
