### 1. 2020 San Francisco Reproductive Justice Summit: Black Women Know

The <u>Reproductive Justice Summit</u> will bring together Black/African American community members and health care providers to challenge the prevalence of anti-black racism within the healthcare and safety-net system in San Francisco. The primary goals of the summit are to:

- 1. Address the inequities in reproductive health outcomes experienced by Black/African American people in San Francisco by destigmatizing STDs and promoting sexual agency;
- 2. Develop actionable recommendations to improve racial equity and cultural responsiveness in the provision of sexual health services at San Francisco safetynet clinics.

The summit will be held Friday, April 24th and Saturday, April 25th 2020 at the CCSF Southeast Community Facility.

While each is designed for a different audience – managers or office staff – they share a common objective of having participants learn simple service protocols to ensure consistent, outstanding service in every department and site.



The Facility Site Review (FSR) Team is proud to introduce you to the updated Facility Site Review (FSR) content on the San Francisco Health Plan (SFHP) website, <a href="www.sfhp.org">www.sfhp.org</a>. Facility Site Reviews are the application of prescribed

California Department of
Health Care Services
(DHCS)/Medi-Cal
Managed Care Division



(MMCD) for all primary care provider (PCP) sites. These standards have been undergoing revisions for the past year by DHCS. New FSR standards will take effect



on July 1, 2020. DHCS' publication of these standards is forthcoming and the SFHP website will have the new All Plan Letter and Standards on our site as soon as they are available. SFHP has been diligently working for several months to prepare every primary care provider site and provider for the changes. One of the most impactful ways to support

our providers and their staff is through online access of FSR information, which is available to you 24/7 and provides an array of documents from pre-survey checklists to operational best-practice examples that have all been created or updated with the new changes in mind.

Forms, checklists, example policies, example procedures, logs, new medication dosage chart, forms, references... plus a Blood Pressure Measurement Toolkit (in Other Resources)

The FSR Team hopes that you will take a moment to access the new content. We would like you to become familiar with the site content as all of the documents are aligned with key Site Review Survey and Medical Record Review criteria to assist you with compliance. These documents will benefit you both in preparing for site audits and to aid you in responding to any potential Corrective Action Plan (CAP) deficiencies found during an audit.


