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Statement from San Francisco Health Plan regarding cuts to Medicaid

At San Francisco Health Plan (SFHP), our mission is to ensure San Francisco's most vulnerable communities have access to quality care. The federal government's \$1.1 trillion cut in health care funding puts the well-being of 14 million Medi-Cal members across the state at risk, including Bay Area residents.

Medicaid is more than healthcare—the work we do in partnership with local hospitals, clinics, and community organizations keeps our communities healthy and productive. As we begin to understand the scope and implications of these federal cuts, we are committed to working with our providers, advocates, and leaders on strategies that will protect health care access for our 180,000 members.
